Both AFRCF and non-AFRCF members are allowed to submit abstracts.

Abstracts should be prepared as following:

- An English language abstract must be in the terminology familiar to specialists.
- The text should be succinct and substantive. Beside presenter's full names and affiliations, the abstract must include: purpose, methods, results, conclusion and significance.
- Submit a document no longer than 500 words.

After consideration and selection by the scientific board, you will be notified if your abstract is considered for poster session or for both poster session and oral communication.

Please select the session in which you consider your abstract would be the most relevant.

Nevertheless, scientific board retains the right to decide which session is the most appropriate.
